(SCDHHS) School-based Mental Health Initiative

**Summary:** In accordance with the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) School-based Mental Health Initiative, effective July 1, 2022: Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services (RBHS) are allowed to be delivered in school settings by Select Health of South Carolina master's level behavioral health providers who are contracted by the school district. Providers are advised to review the recently updated SCDHHS <u>Local Education Agencies (LEA) Services Provider Manual</u>, the <u>LEA School-based Services Alternative Fee Schedule</u> and <u>frequently asked questions (FAQ)</u> document located on the SCDHHS website, <u>www.scdhhs.gov</u> for full details.

## Eligible Provider Types:

- Licensed Independent Social Worker
- Marriage and Family Therapist
- Licensed Professional Counselor
- Licensed Psycho-Educational Specialist
- Licensed Master Social Worker (supervision required\*)
- Mental Health Professional (supervision required RBHS only\*)
- Qualified Clinical Professional (supervision required DMH only)

\*IMPORTANT REMINDER: SCDHHS supervision limitation of 6 individuals per supervisor still applies as outlined in the SCDHHS Licensed Independent Practitioners (LIPS) Manual. Also, supervisors are only allowed to supervise like-licensure clinicians and <u>cannot</u> supervise an independently licensed clinician.

- > Services Eligible in the School-based Setting:
  - Diagnostic Assessment- Initial and Follow up (90791/H0031)
  - Service Plan Development (H0032)
  - Crisis Management (H2011 post-event notification required via Crisis Intervention form.)
  - Individual Psychotherapy (90832/90834/90837 6/month, any combination)
  - Family Psychotherapy (90846/90847)
  - Group Psychotherapy (90853)

## > Provider Enrollment:

- **Existing LIPS and RBHS providers,** School districts and, DMH providers will <u>not</u> need to complete a new application. However, submission of a fully-executed agreement with a SC School District to <u>state\_contracts@scdhhs.gov</u> is required prior to rendering services.
- **Unenrolled RBHS providers** will need to complete the Healthy Connections Medicaid provider application, located on the SCDHHS website and a Select Health credentialing application.
  - A Training Video for School-based Provider Enrollment process is available on SCDHHS' website.
  - o SCDHHS will begin enrolling new RBHS providers for the purpose of delivering RBHS to students in school-based settings on or after July 11, 2022.
  - In addition to all standard enrollment information, a copy of the fully-executed school
    district agreement(s) indicating the school(s) in which services will be provided must be
    submitted to: <a href="mailto:state\_contracts@scdhhs.gov">state\_contracts@scdhhs.gov</a>.
